Summary:

in 1999 the case of *Redmond-Bate v DPP* went before the Queen's Bench Division of the High Court. The circumstances of the conviction had been the following: R-B was one of three Christian women preaching from the steps of a cathedral. Complaints were made about them and a police officer warned the women not to stop pedestrians. The officer returned later to find a crowd had gathered and that some of its members were now angry with the preachers. The officer feared a breach of the peace and asked the women to desist. When they refused, they were arrested. R-B was later convicted of obstruction. **Lord Justice Sedley quashed the conviction, noting that "a key question for the constable was, from whom was the threat coming, the preachers or the crowd; because it was there that the preventive**

action should have been directed.”
